Please meet Able Seaman Andy Miller. He is a Great War Royal Australian Navy bear.

These bears are kindly donated to schools to help students connect with the stories of service and sacrifice of our military personnel, that we celebrate every year at special times around Anzac day and Remembrance Day.

Able Seaman Miller's story is presented on a card that accompanies the bear for the children to read and discuss.

Our bear has been kindly donated to our school by Mr Mostyn Berryman who was member of the Royal Australian Navy during World War 11.

He was a member of Special Operations Australia from Z Special Unit. This special unit carried out a raid on shipping in Japanese-occupied Singapore harbour between September and October 1943. This raid on Singapore Harbour was called Operation Jaywick.

Mr Berryman is also the grandfather of Mrs Ali Smith, a teacher in our school. We thank them both so much for thinking of us, and we are very proud to provide a home for Able Seaman Miller in our school library.
